## STATEMENT OF SUBMISSION AND ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD

This document constitutes the formal submission of my candidacy for the position of Director General of the Genocide and Resistance Research Centre of Lithuania in response to the publicly announced competition.

This submission also serves as a complete administrative record of my application, including the qualifications I present, the documentation I have provided, and the procedural notices I have placed on record concerning the conduct of the selection process.

The purpose of structuring this submission as an administrative record is threefold:

1. Compliance — to demonstrate full compliance with the requirements stated in the official vacancy announcement.
2. Transparency — to ensure that the evaluation of my candidacy occurs within a framework of procedural transparency consistent with the principles of good administration recognized under European Union law.
3. Public Accountability — to preserve an accurate and verifiable record of this selection process for scholarly, institutional, and public review.

Because the work of the Genocide and Resistance Research Centre of Lithuania concerns matters of profound historical importance, the integrity of the selection process for its leadership is itself a matter of legitimate public interest.

This submission is prepared in English for purposes of international transparency and public accountability.



The principles described in that document represent minimum institutional requirements. Upon assuming the position, I will conduct a full institutional review to determine what further reforms are necessary to transform the Genocide and Resistance Research Centre of Lithuania into a legitimate institution of historical scholarship rather than a source of historically misleading publications.

Primary objectives include:

- Full transparency of archival holdings
- Digital public access to archives
- Removal of political influence from research
- International academic standards
- Structural reform of methodology
- Independent peer review of publications
- Institutional transparency

**Demonstrated Precedent: The Maceva Project**

I led the Maceva Project, which identified, mapped, and worked toward the preservation of abandoned Jewish cemeteries across Lithuania. This project directly fulfils the Centre's statutory mandate to preserve evidence of Jewish life and the consequences of the Holocaust in Lithuania. No other candidate can demonstrate comparable on-the-ground preservation work within Lithuanian territory.

**Demonstrated Precedent: The Jonas Noreika Campaign**

The LGGRTC issued historical findings on Jonas Noreika that were subsequently rejected by Lithuania's own Presidential Commission. I personally funded and conducted the legal and research campaign that exposed those findings as institutionally compromised. This record establishes the independence and resolve to pursue institutional accountability at the level the Director General role demands. No other candidate has demonstrated a comparable willingness to hold this institution to the standards its own government requires.

**4. DOCUMENTATION OF ACADEMIC AND MANAGERIAL EXPERIENCE**

I have requested clarification regarding what specific documentation the Council considers acceptable for demonstrating academic and managerial experience. No clarification has been provided. I therefore reject any attempt to rely on ambiguity or procedural technicalities to exclude my candidacy.



## **18. NOTICE OF SELECTIVE ENFORCEMENT OF HISTORICAL STANDARDS**

On 26 February 2026, a Vilnius court convicted activist Erika Švenčionienė for minimization of Soviet crimes, establishing that public statements concerning historical events can constitute criminal offences under Lithuanian law. The same criminal standard has never been applied to LGGRTC publications that minimized, obscured, or distorted the Lithuanian record of Holocaust perpetration. The Director General of this institution bears institutional responsibility for any such asymmetry. This notice is placed on the formal record of this candidacy.

## **19. NOTICE OF ONGOING INTERNATIONAL SCRUTINY**

The institutional conduct of the LGGRTC has attracted scrutiny from Members of the United States Congress and from international Holocaust research institutions. This scrutiny is ongoing. The Director General appointed through this process will inherit full institutional responsibility for LGGRTC's published record and for any subsequent review of that record
