As new public discussions have begun regarding [Jonas Noreika – General Vėtra](#) (1910-1947), we are publishing the LGGRT Center's responses to the "69-page investigation" by Lithuanian citizen GA Gochins about J. Noreika. We would like to draw your attention to the fact that the LGGRT Center has been responding to GA Gochins' accusations for several years, which are only getting stronger and wider (see response 1).

In his latest letters to the LGGRT Center regarding K. Škirpa and J. Noreika, GAG Gochins reveals the essence of his "investigations": he is trying to prove that the Holocaust was started not by the Nazis, but by Lithuanians (responses 4, 5, 25, etc.).

In GAG Gochin's "investigation" of J. Noreika, without providing solid evidence, and possibly violating the Constitution of the Republic of Lithuania and the Criminal Code of the Republic of Lithuania, many individuals are accused: the Prime Minister of the Provisional Government Juozas Brazaitis, whose activities were thoroughly investigated in 1975 at the request of the US Congress and he was rehabilitated by the US Department of Justice, political prisoner Viktoras Ašmenskas, etc. (see answer 1).

GA Gochin's accusations of the Holocaust against the Bishop of Telšiai Vincentas Borisevičius, who was shot by the Soviets in 1946, and other priests of the Telšiai diocese, are particularly noteworthy, because V. Borisevičius, priests of the Telšiai diocese Vladislovas Polonskis, Vladislavas Taškūnas were awarded by the President of the Republic of Lithuania for rescuing Jews. (see answers 1 and 10).

Trying to belittle J. Noreika and other Lithuanians imprisoned in the Stutthof concentration camp, GA Gochin explains in his "research" that they did not work there, that their activities were not investigated, that they were imprisoned only "as hostages of the Lithuanian nation" (rep. No. 11).
