CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION TRANSMITTAL LETTER

Consistent with sections 7015 and 7063 of State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 2024 (Div. F, P.L. 118-47), as carried forward by the Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2025 (Div. A, P.L. 119-4), and section 34 of the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956 (22 U.S.C. 2706), the Department of State (the Department) is notifying its intent to undertake a reorganization of its domestic operations and functions by July 1, 2025.

In order to more closely align resources with core U.S. national security and foreign policy objectives, the Department intends to restructure or eliminate certain bureaus and offices that no longer advance such Department and Administration priorities. The Department will also restructure certain bureaus and offices that would implement programs and functions realigned from USAID.

The planned changes are explained further in the attached enclosure.

CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION

Introduction

The Department of State is notifying Congress of its intent to reorganize the Department's domestic operations, including more than 300 bureaus and offices, to refocus on core U.S. foreign policy objectives and the needs of contemporary diplomacy. The planned changes are also reflective of the Administration's and Secretary's broader efforts to streamline government functions, eliminate redundancy, and enhance accountability. To execute on and conform with the reorganization, the Department is also notifying that certain bureau managed funds will be reprogrammed to new bureaus. While funding changes may be fluid, the Department is committed to continuing to work with Congress to provide additional budgetary information as it becomes available.

Background

The Department is the primary arm of American diplomacy across more than 200 nations. Although its primary mission is representing the United States abroad, the Department's domestic operations have grown considerably over the last 25 years. The resulting proliferation of bureaus and offices with unclear, overlapping, or duplicative mandates has hobbled the Department's ability to rapidly respond to emerging threats and crises, or to effectively advance America's affirmative interests across the world. The Secretary believes that effective modern diplomacy requires streamlining this bloated bureaucracy, and this reorganization is calibrated to ensure that the Department's operations, from its regional diplomatic core to its foreign assistance capacities, are maximally efficient and fully aligned with and support core U.S. national security and foreign policy objectives. The Secretary expects this exercise will result in a nimbler and more proactive Department that is better able to advance the Administration's foreign policy priorities. Moreover, our embassies and diplomats in the field will be newly empowered to advance America's interests abroad.

Modernizing and Streamlining the Department's Structure

To address these structural problems of bureaucratic overgrowth and overlapping office mandates, the Department will eliminate non-statutory offices whose roles do not align with core U.S. national security or foreign policy objectives, or whose functions overlap with or duplicate those of other offices. Where appropriate, these offices' functions and associated positions will be realigned elsewhere in the Department. Other offices and their associated positions will be realigned to other bureaus in the Department to streamline reporting chains. These changes, reflected in the organizational chart at Tab 1 and described in detail in Tab 2, are summarized here.

The Department's regional bureaus – which are responsible for overall management of U.S. bilateral relationships around the world – are at the center of U.S. foreign policy. Functional and assistance considerations must be “mainstreamed” in their decision-making to ensure that local

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and regional equities are considered, and that functional and assistance decisions are consistent with overall diplomatic strategy. To the maximum extent possible, existing regional bureau offices that handle cross-cutting issues will take over management of functional policies from other bureaus and offices in the Department. Further, in their new or expanded assistance offices, regional bureaus will take over policy management of almost all non-security foreign assistance.

Management of security assistance and related policy will generally be consolidated under the Under Secretary (U/S) for Arms Control and International Security (T) so it can be managed comprehensively. The T family will also consolidate most of the Department's defense and national security related functions: the Bureau of Counterterrorism (CT) and Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (INL) will be realigned to report to the T U/S, and a new Bureau of Emerging Threats (ET) reporting to T will be formed to address novel and emerging security challenges.

As management of functional policy issues and foreign assistance will be returned to the regional bureaus, many functional bureaus and offices under the U/S for Civilian Security, Human Rights, and Democracy (J) will become redundant. These offices, which have proven themselves prone to ideological capture and radicalism, will be either eliminated, with their statutory functions realigned elsewhere in the Department, or restructured to better reflect their appropriate scope and the Administration's foreign policy priorities. Reflecting the overriding principle that regional diplomacy should reside with the regional bureaus, regional offices within J family bureaus will be eliminated, and these bureaus will shift to a more focused issue-oriented organizational structure.

Reflecting the Administration's emphasis on American prosperity, fairness in trading relationships, technological leadership, and management of economic and commercial issues will be unified under the renamed U/S for Economic Growth, Energy, and Environment (E), along with their closely associated science, technology, and health issues. For example, the Bureau of Global Health Security and Diplomacy (GHSD), which will manage complex commercial medical supply chains to support life-saving aid programs, will be realigned to report to the E U/S.

Finally, the Department will consolidate management and administrative support functions to drive uniformity and efficiency. The Department has long had a duplicative and incoherent distribution of management and administrative functions, with bureaus and offices each responsible for their own payments, finance, procurement, hiring, technology management, press and legislative affairs, and administrative support. Where possible, the Department will consolidate these functions at either the family level or within the U/S for Management (M) family. For example, critical management functions – including hiring, procurement, finance, and IT – will generally be consolidated in M family bureaus and offices including the Bureau of the Comptroller and Global Financial Services (CGFS), the Bureau of Diplomatic Technology (DT), the renamed Bureau of Personnel and Training (PERT), and the new Bureau of Global Acquisitions (GA), which will be broken out from the Bureau of Administration (A). Generally, administration

functions performed by bureau-level Executive Director (EX) offices will be consolidated into more efficient family-level EX offices.

Family, Bureau, Office, and Staff Realignments

As part of the reorganization of the Department, bureaus within each of the organizational “families” will be realigned as outlined below and in the attached organizational charts.

Office of the Secretary – “(S) Family”

Executive Secretary (S/ES)

Office of the Executive Director (EX) functions from bureaus in the S family, including the Office of the Legal Adviser (L) and Bureau of Global Health Security and Diplomacy (GHSD) will be realigned to the EX office of the Executive Secretary (S/ES-EX). The Office of Presidential Travel Support (A/PRI/PTS) will also be realigned to S/ES-EX, reflecting the Executive Secretary’s existing responsibilities vis-à-vis Presidential and Secretarial diplomatic travel.

Bureau of Intelligence and Research (INR)

- The Office of Analytic Outreach (INR/AO) will be eliminated.
- The Office of Technical Collection Affairs (INR/TCA) will assume the duties performed by the current Policy Sharing Center (INR/PSC), which will be eliminated.
- The Offices of Analysis of Europe (INR/EUR) and Analysis for Russia and Eurasia (INR/REA) will merge into a new Office of Analysis for Europe and Russia (INR/EUR).
- Positions from INR/REA will be realigned to the Office of Analysis for South Asia (INR/SA) to form the Office for Analysis for South and Central Asia (INR/SCA).
- INR’s Watch (INR/Watch), which is responsible for providing alerts on breaking intelligence, and the Office of Analytic Integration (INR/INT) will merge to form the Office of the Watch and Executive Support (INR/WES). The National and Nuclear Risk Reduction Center currently in the ADS Bureau (ADS/NNRRC) will be realigned into the new INR/WES.
- The three INR Deputy Assistant Secretaries (DASes) and Chief Information Officer (CIO) will report to the INR Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary (PDAS) instead of the INR Assistant Secretary.

Office of the Legal Adviser (L)

- The Office of the Executive Director (L-H/EX) will be eliminated, with five finance positions realigned to CGFS, four IT positions realigned to DT, and twelve positions realigned to S/ES-EX. S/ES-EX will assume primary responsibility for accepting domestic service of legal process on behalf of the Department.
- The Office of the Assistant Legal Adviser for Private International Law (L/PIL) will be eliminated and its functions will be realigned to the Office of the Assistant Legal Adviser for Economic and Business Affairs (L/EB).

- The Office of the Assistant Legal Adviser for Human Rights and Refugees (L/HRR) will be renamed the Office of Human Rights and Migration (L/HRM) to reflect an increased focus on border security issues.

Bureau of Legislative Affairs (H)

The Office of Global Functional Affairs (H/RGF/GF) and the Office of Regional Affairs (H/RGF/R) will be merged into a new consolidated office: the Office of Regional, Global, and Functional Affairs (H/RGF/RGF).

Other S Family Offices

In addition, certain offices formerly directly reporting to the Secretary will either be eliminated or consolidated under an Under Secretary. For example, the Office of Global Women's Issues (S/GWI) will be eliminated. This change will dissolve siloed reporting lines and ensure that promoting women's rights and empowerment is a priority across the full scope of the Department's diplomatic engagement. Special Envoy offices previously reporting directly to the Secretary will instead be realigned under a set of relevant bureaus and offices to ensure that they are fully aligned with the activities and perspectives of relevant regional and functional bureaus. Several Special Envoy offices which are redundant will be either eliminated or merged into bureaus/offices with primary responsibility over their areas of work. For example, the Office of the Special Envoy for Critical and Emerging Technologies (S/TECH) will be eliminated, and its functions will be realigned to the Bureau of Cyberspace and Digital Policy (CDP). Separately, the Bureau of Global Health Security and Diplomacy (GHSD) will be realigned to report to the E U/S to better integrate it with the E family's existing foreign assistance capacities and to better reflect the Bureau's focus on ensuring the security of the global health commodities supply chain and other critical commercial healthcare relationships.

Under Secretary for Political Affairs (P) Family

Bureau of African Affairs (AF)

- The Office of Regional Peace and Security (AF/RPS) will be realigned to a new Office of Assistance (AF/A).
- The Office of South Sudan and Sudan (AF/SSS) will be realigned to the Office of East African Affairs (AF/E). The Special Envoy for Sudan will continue to report directly to the Secretary for statutory functions and will report to the AF Assistant Secretary (A/S) on a day-to-day basis for routine matters.
- AF will divide the Office of Economic and Regional Affairs (AF/ERA) into two separate offices, Commercial and Economic Affairs (AF/CE) and Regional and Multilateral Affairs (AF/RMA).

Bureau of East Asian and Pacific Affairs (EAP)

- The Office of Multilateral Affairs (MLA) will be eliminated. MLA responsibilities with respect to coordinating America's engagements with ASEAN will be realigned to the U.S. Mission to ASEAN in Jakarta, with domestic EAP offices handling other functions.

- The Office of Mainland Southeast Asia (EAP/MTS) and the Office of Maritime Southeast Asia (EAP/MLS) will be merged into a new Office of Southeast Asian Affairs (EAP/SEA). It will also be responsible for current MLA responsibilities for South China Sea coordination, primarily focused on the Philippines and Vietnam, in addition to managing bilateral relations with ASEAN member states.
- The Office of Regional Assistance and Security Programs (EAP/RASP) will be responsible for EAP's foreign assistance functions and lead coordination on regional security issues and the Quad. One position will be realigned from CT to EAP/RASP to serve as an advisor for the region.

Bureau of European Affairs (EUR)

- EUR will reduce six DAS positions to five. One DAS will focus on multilateral functions and offices, three DAS positions will cover bilateral offices, and one DAS will cover cross-cutting offices. The Special Envoy for Belarus will also serve as the DAS responsible for Belarus.
- The Office of Caucasian Affairs (EUR/CARC) will be eliminated, moving coverage of these issues to the Office of Russian Affairs (EUR/RUS), which will be renamed the Office of Russian Affairs and the Caucasus (EUR/RuCas).
- The Office of East European Affairs (EUR/EE) and the Office of Central European Affairs will merge to form a new Office of Eastern and Central European Affairs (EUR/ECE).
- The Office of South Europe (EUR/SE) will be merged into the Office South Central Europe (EUR/SCE).

Bureau of International Organizations Affairs (IO)

- IO will shift to a more field-oriented operation, providing a DAS as a direct point of contact for each of the bureau's 10 ambassadors or senior officers at IO posts. IO will reduce from five DASes and 10 offices to four DASes and seven offices.
- A new Office of Economic and Civil Affairs (IO/ECA) will support IO missions in New York, Rome, Paris, and Nairobi, as well as regional officers working from the U.S. Missions in Addis Ababa, Santiago, and Bangkok. Positions from other IO offices will be realigned to staff this new office.
- A new Office of Security Affairs (IO/OSA) will be established to perform the functions of the existing offices of UN Peacekeeping Operations (IO/PKO) and Sanctions and Counterterrorism (IO/SCT). Positions from CT's Office of Multilateral Affairs (CT/MA) will be realigned to IO/OSA.
- IO/MPR's UN reform and strategic planning unit will be realigned to the office of Multilateral Strategic Affairs (IO/MSA).
- A new Office of Planning, Finance, and Oversight (IO/OPF) will be established to perform the functions of the current IO/Conferences office and the finance unit of IO/MPR, which will be realigned to IO/OPF.
- The former IO Office of Public Affairs and Outreach (IO/PAO) will be renamed Office of Public and Congressional Affairs (IO/PCA).

Bureau of Near Eastern Affairs (NEA)

- NEA will reorganize reporting lines and reduce eight DAS positions to four.
- The Iran and Iraq offices within NEA will be merged to establish an Office of Iranian and Iraqi Affairs (NEA/IIR).
- CT Advisor positions will be realigned from CT to NEA, which will be embedded within regional desks covering Israel, the Levant, North Africa, Iran/Iraq, and the Arabian Peninsula.

Bureau of South and Central Asian Affairs (SCA)

- SCA will reduce four DAS positions to three.
- The Coordinator for Afghan Relocation Efforts (CARE) Office will be eliminated and its functions will be realigned to the Afghanistan Affairs Office.
- The legacy Special Representative for Afghan Reconstruction (SRAR) will be eliminated.
- The Office of Security and Transnational Affairs (SCA/STA) will be eliminated, with its functions assumed by a new Office of Foreign Assistance (SCA/FA), which will manage all regional foreign assistance activities.
- Four positions will be realigned from CT to SCA to support regional counterterrorism programming.

Bureau of Western Hemisphere Affairs (WHA)

- The functions and personnel of the Office of Haitian Affairs (WHA/HA) will be merged into the Office of Caribbean Affairs (WHA/CAR).
- A WHA Office of Assistance Coordination will be established to manage foreign assistance activities in the region.
- Positions will be realigned from CT to WHA to support regional counterterrorism programming, particularly in the narco-terrorism space.

Under Secretary for Economic Growth, Energy, and the Environment (E) Family

- The Bureau of Energy Resources (ENR) will be eliminated. ENR's statutory functions, and other critical activities, including those performed by the Office of Critical Minerals and Energy Technology (ENR/ETR/CMET), will be realigned to the Bureau of Economic, Energy and Business Affairs (EEB). Reflecting its enhanced energy responsibilities, the EEB bureau will return to its pre-2011 nomenclature.
- The Office of the U.S. Coordinator for the Partnership for Global Infrastructure and Investment (PGI) will be realigned to report to the Assistant Secretary for Economic and Business Affairs.
- The Bureau of Cyberspace and Digital Policy (CDP) will be realigned to report to the E U/S. See Tab 4. The offices of the Special Envoy for Critical and Emerging Technology (S/TECH), OES Office of Science and Technology Cooperation (OES/S/STC), and the Science and Technology Adviser (STAS) will be eliminated, with their functions realigned to CDP. These offices will report to a new DAS for Critical & Emerging Technologies (CET).

- The Bureau of Global Health Security and Diplomacy (GHSD) will report to the E U/S. The Ambassador-At-Large for Global Health Security and Diplomacy will continue to report directly to the Secretary for statutory functions but will report to E on a day-to-day basis for routine matters. As noted, this shift will better reflect the bureau's critical engagement on health supply chains and commercial matters. Within GHSD, the Office of Strategy, Communications, and Health Engagement (GHSD/SCE) will be eliminated, and its functions and positions will be realigned to other offices within GHSD.
- Within the Bureau of Oceans and International Environmental and Scientific Affairs (OES) the Office of Science and Technology Cooperation, the Office of Global Change, and the Office of Policy and Public Outreach will be eliminated, and their functions will be realigned to other offices in OES as appropriate.
- The Department's sanctions authorities will also be consolidated into one vertical to enhance the coherence and responsiveness of sanctions policy. The Office of Sanctions Coordination (SC) will continue to report directly to the Secretary for statutory functions but will report to E on a day-to-day basis for routine matters. The Head of the Office of Sanctions Coordination will also serve as the EEB DAS for Counter Threat Finance and Sanctions, reporting to EEB Assistant Secretary in that capacity.
- The non-centralized functions of the four bureau EX offices will be consolidated into one office (E/EX). Positions from the OES-DRL/EX office will be realigned to the new F/EX to continue to support DRL functions.

Under Secretary for Arms Control and International Security (T) Family

- The Bureau of International Security and Nonproliferation (ISN) and the Bureau of Arms Control, Deterrence, and Stability (ADS) will be merged into a new Bureau of Arms Control and Nonproliferation (ACN) to streamline and rationalize the Department's efforts on nuclear policy and nonproliferation.
- The Special Advisor on AUKUS (T/AUKUS), who will align AUKUS Pillar I and II with broader security cooperation efforts, will report directly to the Secretary for statutory functions, but will report to the T U/S on a day-to-day basis for routine matters.
- The EX offices for ISN and CT will be consolidated in a new T/EX office, which will serve the entire family. Financial functions will be realigned from ISN/EX and CT/EX to CGFS.
- The public affairs and congressional functions from all T family bureaus will be consolidated into a new T/Outreach office.

Bureau of Arms Control and Nonproliferation (ACN)

- The new ACN bureau will be led by a PDAS and 4 DAS positions overseeing:
 - Four offices responsible for counterproliferation, sanctions, technology protection, and export control efforts;
 - Four offices that will implement nonproliferation and other security assistance programs; and
 - Two offices and senior advisors that will lead nonproliferation policy; and

- Three offices that manage arms control, verification and compliance, and extended deterrence and reassurance initiatives.

Bureau of Counterterrorism (CT)

- CT will continue to be led by the Coordinator for Counterterrorism, subject to Senate advice and consent, and will report to the T U/S to allow better coordination with the interagency on sensitive security matters.
- CT's regional functions, offices, and personnel will be realigned to the relevant regional bureaus, and the CT office will be refocused on its intra-agency and inter-agency coordination role.
- Functions and positions of the Office of Multilateral Affairs (CT/MA) will be realigned to the Bureau of International Organizations (IO).
- Functions and positions of the Office of the Executive Director (CT/EX) will be realigned T/EX and CGFS, and public affairs positions will be realigned to T/Outreach.
- The Office of the Special Envoy for the Coalition to Defeat ISIS (CT/SECI), the Deputy Coordinator for Regional and Multilateral Affairs, and the Deputy Special Envoy will be consolidated into the new Office of CT Coordination (CT/CC).
- The Office of Terrorist Detentions will be merged into the Office of Military Coordination and Crisis Response (CT/MCCR).
- The Office of Countering Violent Extremism (CT/CVE) and the Office of Strategy, Plans, and Initiatives (CT/SPI) will be eliminated, and their functions will be realigned to other offices in CT.

Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (INL)

- The Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (INL) will report to the T U/S to refocus its operations on core national security matters and to improve coordination on global law enforcement and security coordination.
- INL will reduce four DAS positions to three.
- The Knowledge Management (INL/KM), Global Policy and Programs (INL/GPP), and Aviation (INL/A) offices will be consolidated into a new Office of Aviation and Cross-Border Programs (INL/ACB) and a new Office of Program Impact and Criminal Deterrence (INL/ICD).
- The Coordinator on Global Anti-Corruption (CGAC) within the INL Front Office will be eliminated, and related statutory functions will be realigned to the Office of Program Impact and Criminal Deterrence (INL/ICD).
- The Office of the Executive Director (EX) will be renamed as the Office of Security Assistance and Operations (INL/SAO), which will also include training functions realigned from the Office of Knowledge Management. Contracting functions and personnel of INL/EX will be realigned to GA.
- The Office of Afghanistan and Pakistan Programs (INL/AP) will be eliminated, and its functions realigned to other INL offices.

Bureau of Emerging Threats (ET)

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- A Bureau of Emerging Threats (ET) will be established, combining elements realigned from CDP and ADS. ET will have dedicated teams to address emerging security threats such as lethal autonomous weapons, AI, the militarization of space, and engineered bioweapons.
- The new ET bureau will include:
 - The Office of Global Policy, Plans and Negotiations, realigned from CDP.
 - The Office of International Engagement and Capacity Building, realigned from CDP.
 - The Office of Threat Management and Operational Coordination, realigned from CDP.
 - The Office of Emerging Security Challenges, realigned from ADS.

Bureau of Political-Military Affairs (PM)

- The Bureau of Political-Military Affairs (PM) will be reorganized to centralize security assistance and consolidate advisors to and from the Department of Defense in a single team. In particular, the Military Advisor (MILAD) and Political Advisor (POLAD) offices will be merged into a new Office of State-Defense Exchange (PM/SDE) to consolidate interagency engagement with the Department of Defense.
- The functions of the Office of Global Programs and Initiatives (PM/GPI) will be realigned to the Office of Security Assistance (PM/SA) to consolidate security assistance authorities into a single office.

Under Secretary for Public Diplomacy (R) Family

Under the planned reorganization:

- The 30 offices currently in the R family will be consolidated to 21 offices.
- The Bureau of Global Public Affairs (GPA) will merge the Office of Creative (GPA/DC/CR) and the Office of Audience Distribution and Strategy (GPA/DC/ADS) to form a single Office of Content Strategy (GPA/DC/CS).
- Functions related to the National Museum of American Diplomacy will be realigned to the A Bureau.
- GPA/EX and ECA/EX will be eliminated, with their functions either transferred to the M family shared services offices or assumed by the family-level consolidated EX function within the Office of Policy, Planning and Resources (R/PPR).
- The Office of Global Partnerships (E/GP) and the Coordinator for Digital Freedom (CDP/CDF) will be also realigned to the policy support function in R/PPR.

Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs (ECA)

- ECA will eliminate its New York City-based staff within the Office of International Visitors, which will also allow the Department to eliminate leased space in the high-cost New York market.
- ECA will eliminate the Office of the Speakers Program (ECA/PE/S) and transfer its functions to the Office of International Visitors (ECA/PE/V).

- ECA will eliminate the Office of Global Educational Programs (ECA/A/S) and transfer its functions between the Office of Academic Exchanges (ECA/A/E) and Office of American Spaces (ECA/P/AS).
- ECA will consolidate the Office of Private Sector Program Administration (OPA) and the Office of Exchange Coordination & Compliance (ECC) into a single office to manage private sector exchange program administration and compliance, streamlining operations.

Under Secretary for Management (M) Family

The M family plan is focused on consolidating core functions into a new shared services model for payments, human resources, IT and other critical services. Within that framework:

- IT professionals from 7 bureaus will consolidate within Diplomatic Technology (DT) to reduce duplicative services and ensure enterprise-wide solutions to technology requirements.
- A new Bureau of Global Acquisitions (GA) will improve efficiency and harness greater buying power and leverage. GA will be responsible for most procurement functions across the Department.
- Finance positions from multiple bureaus will be consolidated in the Bureau of the Comptroller and Financial Services (CGFS), centralizing accounting and finance functions.
- The Bureau of Global Talent Management will be renamed the Bureau of Personnel and Training (PERT) and will centralize most personnel support functions.
- The Foreign Service Institute (FSI) will return to using the George P. Shultz National Foreign Affairs Training Center (NFATC) name. Its component offices will be realigned into PERT to create a holistic approach to personnel recruitment, training, retention, and exits.
- The Office of Management Strategy and Solutions' (M/SS) will be eliminated, and its functions will be realigned to M/EX, DT, and CGFS.
- Policy, compliance, and other support services for the M family will be consolidated into a new EX office (M/EX). M/EX will also be responsible for Advanced Projects and Policy and Global Presence teams realigned from M/SS, as well as language services.

Bureau of Administration (A)

- The Office of Global Acquisition (A/GA) will be established as a separate Bureau of Global Acquisition (M/GA), led by an A/S who will perform the functions of the Chief Acquisition Officer (CAO).
 - A DAS for Acquisition & Assistance Policy will be responsible for centralized acquisition and federal assistance policy, training and oversight functions.
 - A DAS for Federal Assistance Management will be responsible for a shared services federal assistance and grant-making operation.
 - A DAS for Acquisition Management will be responsible for a centralized, shared services procurement operation.

- The Director of the Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization will be realigned from the A bureau and will continue to report to the Deputy Secretary for statutory functions.
 - GA will include positions realigned from A bureau, DS, FSI, INL, and PM
- The Office of the Historian (OH) will be realigned from FSI to A Bureau and report to the DAS for Shared Knowledge Services.
- Responsibility for the National Museum of American Diplomacy (NMAD) will be realigned from R/PPR to the A Bureau.
- Responsibility for Permanent Change of Station functions, which were previously split between PERT and the A Bureau, will be consolidated in one office in A/GO.
- Functions and positions associated with the Art Bank and the Diplomatic Reception Rooms will be realigned from the A Bureau to M/FA.
- The Office of Commissary and Recreation (A/GO/PST/CR) will be eliminated, with certain positions realigned to CGFS.
- The Office of Planning Resources and Innovation will be eliminated, and the human resources, procurement, IT, and financial positions and functions in A/PRI will be realigned to PERT, GA, DT, and CGFS, respectively. The remaining functions and positions in A/PRI will be realigned to M/EX.
- The Bureau Chief Data Officer function will be realigned to the A Bureau Front Office. The Office of Planning and Customer Experience (A/PRI/PCX) will be eliminated, and its functions will be transferred to DT.
- The Office of Language Services (A/PRI/LS) will be consolidated in M/EX.
- The Office of Global Printing Services (A/DOES/ES/GPS) will be eliminated, and its financial services functions and positions will be realigned to CGFS. The printing plants at Embassy Manila and Springfield, VA will close and any remaining functions will be realigned to the Office of General Services Management (A/DOES/GSM).
- The Office of Emergency Management (A/DOES/OEM) will report to the Managing Director for Real Property (A/DOES/RP) rather than the DAS for Domestic Operations and Emergency Services to more closely align emergency services with facilities.
- The Office of Information Access Liaison (A/SKS/IAP/IAL) will be eliminated and its functions will be realigned to the Office of FOIA Case Processing (A/SKS/IAP/FCP) to consolidate FOIA processing into one office.
- The Office of Classification Policy and Declassification Review (A/SKS/IAP/CD) will be eliminated and the functions and related personnel will be realigned to the Office of the Historian and the existing Office of Privacy, Policy, and Knowledge Management. (A/SKS/PPKM).
- The Privacy Office (A/SKS/PPKM/PRV) and Office of Organizational Policy (A/SKS/PPKM/OP) will merge into a new Office of Privacy and Organizational Policy (A/SKS/PPKM/POP) to align information security and policy.
- The Managing Directorate for Strategy and Policy will be eliminated, which will include: eliminating the Office of Policy, Planning, and Analysis; eliminating the Global Fleet Office (A/GO/SP/GF) and realigning its functions and personnel to the Office of Personal Property (A/GO/SP/PP); realigning functions and personnel of the Office of Personal

Property (A/GO/SP/PP) and the Office of Critical Environment and Risk Management (A/GO/SP/CERM) to the existing Post Support and Travel Managing Directorate (A/GO/PST); and realigning certain positions and related functions to DT.

Bureau of the Comptroller General and Financial Services (CGFS)

- The Deputy Comptroller for Financial, Audit, and Technology Management will become the Deputy Comptroller for Policy, Controls, and Technology Management, who will be responsible for financial technology services, establishing financial policies, internal controls, and supporting audit and oversight.
- A new deputy comptroller for Bureau Financial Support Services will be established that will report to the Comptroller and oversee the direct delivery of bureaus' unique needs with specialized services while also standardizing and streamlining common shared financial services.
- The Financial Policy, Reporting, and Analysis directorate, which includes the office of Financial Policy, the office of Financial Reporting and Analysis, and the office of Federal Assistance Financial Management, and the office of Management Controls, will be eliminated. The functions and some of the positions of these offices will be realigned to other CGFS offices.
- A new Office of Financial Policy and Standards and a new Office of Governance and Oversight will be established to provide Department-wide financial policies and standards and oversight of internal controls.
- A new Office of Financial Accounting and Reporting will be established to focus on establishing and implementing policies to meet legal financial reporting requirements, ensuring the accuracy and timeliness of financial data, and recommending improvements to accounting systems.
- The Government Accountability Office Liaison will be eliminated and its functions will be realigned to the new M/EX.
- The Office of Technology Operations, office of Analytics, Cyber, and Government Systems and the Office of Program and Customer Management within the CIO directorate will be eliminated, and its functions and positions will be realigned to a new Office of Financial Technology Services and a new Office of Financial Technology Infrastructure.
- The Center of Excellence for Financial Analysis and Reporting will be established, which will report to the Deputy Comptroller for Policy, Controls, and Technology and will serve as the central hub for advanced financial analysis and improved reporting.
- A new Foreign Assistance and Public Diplomacy directorate will be established, which will include the establishment of the Office of Foreign Assistance Financial Services, Office of Public Diplomacy Financial Services, Office of Economic Growth Financial Services, and Office of International Security Financial Services. Financial positions from other bureaus will be realigned to these new offices.
- A new Consular, Security, and Building Operations directorate will be established, which will include the establishment of the Office of Diplomatic Security Financial Services, Office of Consular Affairs Financial Services, and Office of Overseas Buildings Financial Services. Financial positions from other bureaus will be realigned to these new offices.

- A new Management and Support directorate will be established, which will include the establishment of the office of Administration and Budget Financial Services, Office of Technology Financial Services, and Office of Management Financial Services. Financial positions from other bureaus will be realigned to these new offices.
- The Office of Emergencies in the Diplomatic and Consular Service will be eliminated, and its functions and positions will be realigned to the new office of Management Financial Services.
- The Office of Reports and Reconciliation within the Global Financial Operations directorate will be eliminated, and its functions and positions will be realigned to other CGFS offices.
- A Global Working Capital Fund directorate will be established to provide oversight of the Department working capital fund (WCF). The directorate will include the existing office of the International Cooperative Administrative Support Services and a new office of Working Capital Funds Management that consolidates working capital positions realigned from other bureaus.

Bureau of Consular Affairs (CA)

- The 1CA Leadership, Management, and Innovation Unit will be eliminated.
- The functions of the Office of Career Management in the Passport Services Directorate (CA/PPT/S/CM) and 13 positions in CA/EX will be realigned to PERT.
- The functions of the Office of the Comptroller (CA/C) will be realigned to CGFS.
- There will be no changes to offices or personnel responsible for passports.

Bureau of Diplomatic Security (DS)

- Within the Office of the Executive Director (DS/EX):
 - The Office of the Chief Financial Officer (DS/EX/CFO) will be eliminated, and its functions and most positions will be realigned to CGFS.
 - The Office of Human Resources Management (DS/EX/HRM) will be eliminated, and its functions and most positions will be realigned to PERT.
 - The Office of Management Services (DS/EX/MGT) will be eliminated, and its functions and most positions will be realigned to the new GA.
 - The Office of the Chief Technology Officer (DS/EX/CTO) will be eliminated, and its functions and most positions will be realigned to DT.
 - Remaining positions from these offices will be realigned within DS/EX.
- The Directorate of Cyber and Technology Security (DS/CTS) will be renamed as the Directorate of Cyber Adversary Analysis (DS/CAA). Within that directorate:
 - Responsibility for the security operations center (SOC) and the Cyber Incident Response Team (CIRT) will be realigned to DT and the related positions will be realigned to DT and the Office of Cyber Threat and Investigations (DS/CTS/CTI).
 - The Office of Cyber Monitoring and Operations (DS/CTS/CMO) will be eliminated.
- The High Threat Programs Directorate (DS/HTP) and the International Programs Directorate (DS/IP) will be consolidated and renamed as the Directorate of International and High-Threat Programs (DS/IHP).

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- The DS Resident Offices in St. Albans, VT and Bridgeport, CT, the pilot offices in Las Vegas, NV, Orlando, FL, and Salt Lake City, UT will be closed.
- The Office of Intelligence and Threat Analysis (DS/TIA/ITA) and the Overseas Security Advisory Council (OSAC) will be consolidated into a new Office of Threat Intelligence Analysis and Liaison (DS/TIA/TIAL).
- The Office of Rewards for Justice (DS/TIA/RFJ), the Office of Open-Source Intelligence (DS/TIA/OSN), and the Office of Protective Intelligence and Investigations (DS/TIA/PII) will be consolidated into a new Office of Protective Intelligence (DS/TIA/PI).
- The Office of Protection (DS/DO/P) and the Office of Domestic Facilities Protection (DS/DO/DFP) will be consolidated into a new Office of Protective Services (DS/DO/PS).
- The Office of Investigations (DS/DO/INV) and the Office of Counterintelligence (DS/DO/CI) will be consolidated into a new Office of Investigations and Counterintelligence (DS/DO/ICI).
- The Office Insider Threat Program (DS/SI/ITP) will be eliminated, and the functions and positions associated with the Insider Threat Program will be realigned to the Office of the Director for Security Infrastructure (DS/SI), which will be led by a Director for Security Infrastructure (DS/SI).
- There are no expected changes to DS field offices outside of the Washington, DC metro area. Planned Reduction-In-Force will not affect federal DS Special Agents whose responsibilities include an active law enforcement and security role.

Bureau of Diplomatic Technology (DT)

- The following seven DT offices will be eliminated, with their functions and some positions realigned to other offices within DT: Diplomatic Telecom Service, Strategic Communications Management, External Affairs, Strategy, Planning, and Budget, E-Diplomacy, Infrastructure Strategy and Finance, and Service Strategy and Finance.
- Functions and positions in DT offices related to acquisition, financial, and human resources will be realigned, respectively, to GA, CGFS, and PERT.
- Functions and positions related to information technology, cybersecurity, artificial intelligence, and data functions will be realigned to DT from the bureaus of Administration, DS, Exchanges and Cultural Affairs, Global Health Security and Diplomacy, Global Public Affairs, Medical, PERT, FSI, and the Offices of the Legal Adviser, Foreign Missions, Management Strategy and Solutions, and Policy, Planning, and Resources (within the Office of the Undersecretary for Public Diplomacy).
- The Center for Analytics (M/SS/CfA) will be realigned from M/SS to DT.
- The Office of Consular Systems & Technology (CA/CST) will be realigned to Diplomatic Technology. This will represent a key step in the centralization and integration of the Department's disparate IT systems and will facilitate greater efficiency and interoperability between consular systems and other Department systems and infrastructure.

Bureau of Global Talent Management (GTM)

- GTM will be renamed the Bureau of Personnel and Training (PERT).

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- FSI will return to using the George P. Shultz National Foreign Affairs Training Center (NFATC) name and its component offices will be realigned into PERT.
 - The Provost will report directly to the NFATC Director.
 - FSI's Congressional, strategic communications, and OIG and GAO liaison functions and personnel will be realigned into the PERT Office of Policy, Planning, and Communications.
 - Positions from FSI/EX will be realigned to DT, GA, CGFS, and PERT, and the Office of the Historian will be realigned from FSI to the Bureau of Administration (A).
- Some Civil Service human resources functions from A, CA, DS, ECA, EUR, and FSI will be realigned into PERT Talent Services Office.
- The functions and positions of the CA Passport Services Career Management Office will be realigned to PERT's Directorate of Diplomatic Tradecraft and Emerging Technology.
- The functions and positions of the DT Strategic Workforce Planning Division will be realigned to the PERT Offices of Organization and Talent Analytics, Civil Service Talent Management, Talent Acquisition, and Diplomatic Tradecraft and Emerging Technology.
- The GTM Office of the Executive Director (EX) will be eliminated, and the relevant functions and positions will be realigned to M/EX, CGFS, and DT. The International Domestic Support Division (IDSD) will be realigned to A Bureau.
- The Systems Oversight Division (SOD) will be realigned to the Office of Organization and Talent Analytics.
- The Records and Information Management Division (RIM) will be realigned to a new Office of Operations.
- The remaining GTM and FSI operational functions, including FSI campus operations, will be realigned into the Office of Operations.

Bureau of Medical Services (MED)

- The MED Information Technology unit will be realigned to DT.
- The functions and positions of the Office of the Executive Director will be realigned to M/EX, CGFS
- Consistent with the recommendations of the Office of Inspector General in 2023, MED will:
 - Consolidate management of all medevacs, including mental health and medical cases, under Foreign Programs.
 - Realign Foreign Programs to the Directorate of Operational Medicine, which will be renamed the Directorate of Operations, Readiness, and Security (MED/ORS).
 - Split the Directorate of Mental Health Services into two offices: one for domestic programs, which will be led by a senior psychologist, and one for overseas mental health support, which will be led by a Regional Medical Officer Psychologist.

Bureau of Overseas Building Operations

- OBO's comptroller (OBO/COMP) functions will be realigned to CGFS, along with associated personnel.

- The Office of the Executive Director (OBO/EX) will be eliminated, with support functions performed by the new consolidated M/EX office.
- The Planning and Real Estate Group will centralize planning and advisory functions reducing four offices into three. Specifically, OBO Strategic Planning (OBO/PRE/OSP) will be eliminated, and its functions will be realigned to a centralized Planning Office (OBO/PRE/PO), which will also include the functions and personnel from the Office of Master Planning and Evaluations (OBO/PRE/MPE). The Office of Acquisitions and Disposals will be renamed as the Advisory Office (OBO/PRE/AO) and the Office of Real Property Leasing will be renamed as the Transaction Office (OBO/PRE/TO).
- Art and diplomatic culture functions will be consolidated under a new Managing Director for Cultural Heritage (OBO/CUL), who will oversee the Office of Art in Embassies (OBO/CUL/ART), the Office of Cultural Heritage (OBO/CUL/CH), and the Office of Residential Design and Furnishing (OBO/CUL/RDF).

Office of the Executive Director (M/EX)

- An Office of the Executive Director (M/EX), reporting to the U/S for Management, will be established, comprised of positions realigned from A, CGFS, PERT, MED, and M/SS.

Office of Management Strategy and Solutions (M/SS)

- M/SS will be eliminated, the M/SS Center for Analytics (M/SS/CfA) will be realigned to DT, M/SS budget functions and a related position will be realigned to CGFS, and other M/SS functions and positions will be realigned to M/EX.

Office of Fine Arts (FA)

- The functions and personnel of the Diplomatic Reception Rooms will be realigned from the Events Management Division (A/DOES/GSM/EMH/EM) and the Art Bank Program (A/DOES/ES/GSM) in the Bureau of Administration to M/FA.

Office of Foreign Missions (OFM)

- The Office of Operations will be eliminated, and its functions and positions will be realigned to other offices.
- The Accreditation, Services, and Benefits Division will be realigned to report to the Office of Policy and Reciprocity.
- The Office of the Executive Director (OFM/EX) will be eliminated, and the relevant functions and positions will be realigned to M/EX and CGFS.
- The Information Services Division will be eliminated, and its functions and positions will be realigned to DT.
- The functions and positions of the Office of the Chief of Protocol (S/CPR) Domestic Worker Oversight Program will be realigned to OFM.
- The functions and positions of the USUN Host Country Affairs team will be realigned to OFM's New York Regional Office.

Under Secretary for Civilian Security, Democracy, and Human Rights (J) Family

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- The under Secretary for Civilian Security, Democracy, and Human Rights (J) will be eliminated.
- An Under Secretary for Foreign Assistance and Humanitarian Affairs (F) will be appointed by the President, subject to Senate advice and consent. We anticipate that the President would also designate the F U/S as the Special Coordinator for International Disaster Assistance.
- Existing J front office positions will be realigned to the new F front office.
- The Bureau of Conflict and Stabilization Operations will be eliminated. The statutory functions of the Coordinator for Reconstruction and Stabilization and the related office will be realigned to PRM. The new Coordinator will also be responsible for critical disaster response functions inherited from USAID.
- The Office of Global Criminal Justice (GCJ) will be eliminated, and its statutory functions will be realigned to the Office of the Legal Adviser.
- The F family will have a consolidated EX function (F/EX). This office will be comprised of positions consolidated from the EX offices for PRM and DRL-OES, as well as administrative positions from the existing Office of Foreign Assistance.
- F will have a family-level consolidated press and legislative affairs office, the Office of External & Legislative Affairs (F/ELA). The office will be comprised of certain positions realigned from DRL's Office of Policy Planning and Public Diplomacy (DRL/PPD) and the Office of Foreign Assistance.
- The Office of Global Food Security (GFS) will be realigned to F in order to ensure close coordination with PRM on humanitarian assistance.

Bureau of Democracy, Human Rights and Labor (DRL)

- DRL's existing functions will move from a regionalized model to a leaner subject-matter model.
- The Office to Monitor and Combat Trafficking (J/TIP), the Office of the Ambassador At Large for Int'l Religious Freedom (J/IRF) and the Office to Monitor and Combat anti-Semitism (J/SEAS) – will report on a day-to-basis to the DRL A/S, although IRF and SEAS will continue to report directly to the Secretary for statutory functions.
- The majority of DRL's regional offices will be eliminated, although some personnel from DRL regional offices will be realigned to DRL's new functional offices.
- DRL's remaining functions will be focused on advancing the Administration's affirmative vision of American and Western values. Consequently, DRL's former functions will be consolidated into three offices under a new DAS for Democracy & Western Values.
 - The Office of Natural Rights (DRL/NR) will ground the Department's values-based diplomacy in traditional western conceptions of core freedoms and advance the Department's affirmative vision of civil liberties. For example, the office will build the foundation for criticisms of free speech backsliding in Europe and other developed nations. DRL/NR will be staffed by positions realigned from DRL's regional EUR and EAP offices, as well as positions realigned from DRL's Policy Planning and Public Diplomacy office (DRL/PPD).

- The Office of Free Markets and Free Labor (DRL/MNL) will refocus existing international labor policy engagement toward the promotion of free market principles and efforts to ensure that American works compete in a fair and open global labor playing field. DRL/MNL will be staffed by positions realigned from the DRL Office of International Labor Affairs (DRL/ILA), along with personnel realigned from DRL/EAP.
- The Office of Sanctions & Reporting (DRL/REP) will oversee DRL's functions related to report coordination and human rights sanctions authorities and will ensure effective implementation of high-profile statutory reports and the appropriate utilization of available sanctions authorities in line with Administration priorities (e.g. the Global Magnitsky Act). DRL/REP office will be staffed by personnel realigned from DRL's existing Security & Human Rights Office (DRL/SHR), DRL's Office of Reports (DRL/REP) and positions realigned from the EUR and EAP regional offices within DRL.
- The Office of Multilateral and Global Affairs (DRL/MLGA) and Office of Global Programming (DRL/GP) will be eliminated. Continued program management responsibilities for DRL managed funds will be assumed by the DRL Assistant Secretary and DRL front office, with support from the expanded shared services payments and grant-making functions being created in the M family (M/CGFS and M/GA) and by the F/EX and F Program Management offices.
- The Office to Monitor and Combat Trafficking in Persons (J/TIP) will report to the DRL A/S and will be refocused on its core statutory report-writing function.

Bureau of Population, Refugees, and Migration (PRM)

- PRM will be substantially reorganized from a regional organizational model to a tailored functional structure.
- As part of the USAID integration, PRM will be responsible for the U.S. government's primary international disaster assistance (DART) functions. These functions will be consolidated under the Coordinator for Reconstruction and Stabilization, subject to Senate advice and consent. The Coordinator will directly report to the Secretary for statutory functions related to crisis response and will perform both disaster response and other crisis response functions previously performed by the Bureau of Conflict Stabilization Operations (CSO). Until a Coordinator is confirmed by the Senate, the Department anticipates the duties and functions of the office to be performed by a former USAID foreign service officer with extensive experience in disaster and humanitarian response.
 - PRM's global network of humanitarian coordinators will be reorganized under the Coordinator for Reconstruction and Stabilization to provide a global network of pre-positioned disaster and crisis response coordinators. The Coordinator will also be able to pull from the Office of Global Food Security (GFS) to consolidate disaster response resources as necessary.
 - Both PRM and GFS are receiving a considerable number of new positions in connection with the transition of programs from USAID. These positions have been carefully targeted to ensure adequate expertise in humanitarian aid, crisis

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mitigation, and disaster response. PRM and GFS personnel will cross-train on a regular basis to ensure close coordination during an emergency response scenario.

- PRM's existing migration functions will be consolidated into three new functional offices under a DAS for Migration Matters. Reflecting core Administration priorities, these offices will be substantially reorganized to shift focus towards supporting the Administration's efforts to return illegal aliens to their country of origin or legal status.
 - The Office of Remigration (PRM/REM) will serve as PRM's hub for immigration issues and repatriation tracking. It will provide a policy platform for interagency coordination with DHS and other agencies on removals/repatriations, and for intra-agency policy work to advance the President's immigration agenda. Using MRA funds, PRM/REM will also actively facilitate the voluntary return of migrants to their country of origin or legal status. PRM/REM will be initially staffed by personnel realigned from PRM's Office of Western Hemisphere Affairs (PRM/WHA) and portions of PRM's Office of International Migration (PRM/IM) with expertise in Temporary Protected Status and other relevant issues.
 - The Office of International Migration and Repatriation (PRM/IMR) will serve as PRM's consolidated office for the management of migration data tracking, policy work, and multilateral engagement. It will assume responsibility of PRM's PRISM migration data tracking system from PRM/PRP. PRM/IMR will be staffed by personnel realigned from PRM's Office of Multilateral and External Coordination (PRM/MEC) and Office of International Migration (PRM/IM).
 - The Office of Refugee Processing (PRM/RP) will be a renamed and rescoped version of the current Office of Refugee Admissions (PRM/A).
- Other existing PRM functional offices will be eliminated, with certain functions realigned to other offices.
- The Office of the Comptroller (PRM/C) will be realigned to F/EX to provide program support across the new family, with some financial positions being realigned to CGFS.
- The Office of Policy & Resource Planning (PRM/PRP) and Office of Public and Congressional Affairs (PRM/PCA) will be eliminated. Legislative and press affairs support for PRM will be provided by the new F/LEA.

Director for Foreign Assistance Oversight

- The existing Office of Foreign Assistance will be reorganized into four new consolidated verticals in a new Office of Foreign Assistance Oversight (F/FAO) to better deliver Department-wide monitoring, evaluation, budget and planning, oversight, and program management of foreign assistance.
 - The Office of Monitoring, Evaluation & Vetting (F/MEV) will represent the Department's first consolidated and specialized monitoring, evaluation, and vetting function. This office will be critical to deliver on the Secretary's promise of greater accountability in the delivery of foreign assistance in a post-USAID era. F/MEV will administer vetting and monitoring systems and integrate F's existing data and monitoring personnel.

- The Office of Foreign Assistance Budget & Planning (F/BP) will continue to provide critical Department and government-wide foreign assistance budget and planning support.
- The Office Foreign Assistance Policy (F/POL) will provide policy and strategic support for the Department's bureaus assuming new foreign assistance responsibilities. F/POL will also take on certain statutory policy and reporting duties, including responsibilities related to the Global Fragility Act currently performed by CSO.
- The Office of Foreign Assistance Program Management (F/GPM) will provide specialized program management support for foreign assistance programs across the Department.

The Department does not currently plan to propose legislative changes in connection with the organizational changes outlined in this notification, but will engage Congress if any legislative changes are identified as plans develop.

The Department plans to provide additional information regarding planned reallocations of personnel and the related reprogramming of funding in subsequent briefings and congressional notifications.

Planned Reductions to the Department's Domestic Workforce

The Department plans to reduce its Civil Service and Foreign Service domestic workforce by up to 3,448 personnel from baseline staffing levels as of May 4, 2025. These reductions include a planned Reduction-In-Force (RIF) of up to 1,873 personnel assigned to domestic offices and up to 1,575 already indicated voluntary departures, such as through employee participation in the Department's two previously offered Deferred Resignation Programs (DRP). These reductions, organized by family, are shown in the table below.

RIF plans have been carefully tailored, consistent with applicable law, to preserve core functions. Reductions will not impact personnel within Consular Affairs' passport or visa operations, federal DS Special Agents whose responsibilities include an active law enforcement and security role, or personnel assigned to a regional bureau country "desk." Rather, reductions will principally affect non-core functions, duplicative or redundant offices, and offices where considerable efficiencies may be found from centralization or consolidation of functions and responsibilities.

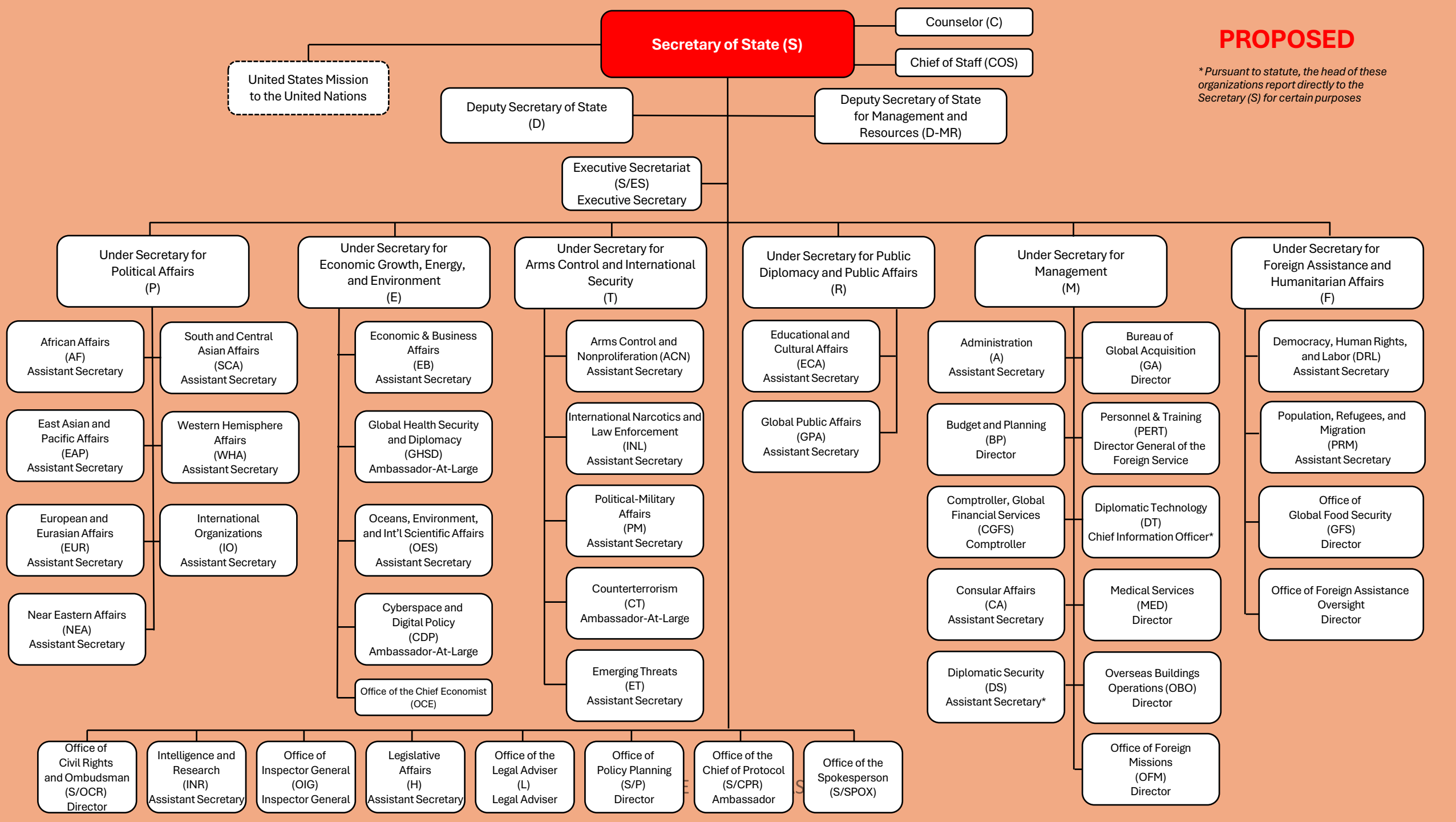
No RIFs are planned for locally employed staff or U.S. direct hire personnel posted overseas.

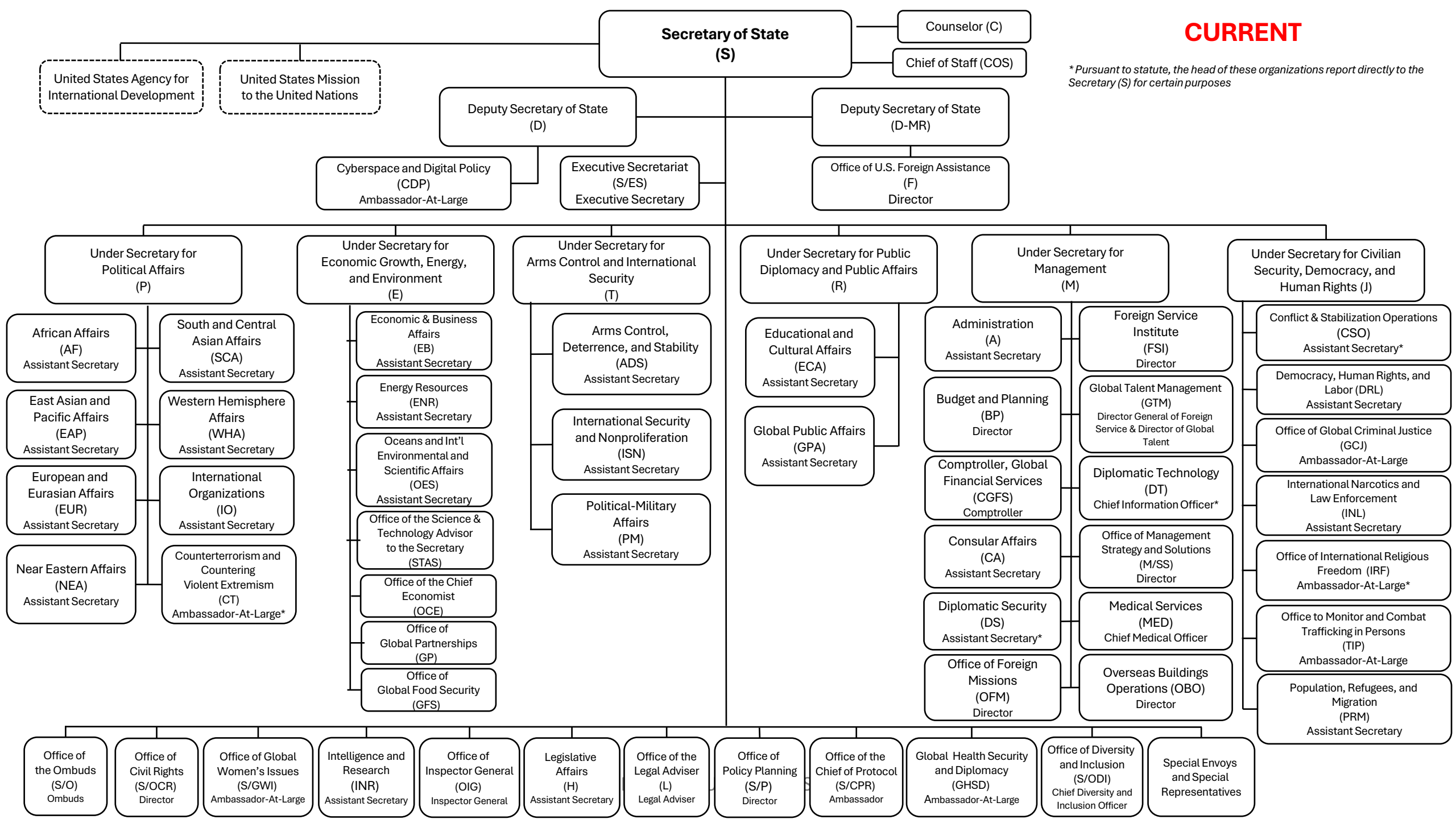

Planned Reprogramming

The table in Tab 3 outlines the planned reprogramming of resources for the offices, functions and personnel realigned between bureaus. The amounts shown are based on full-year FY 2025 cost estimates for the salaries of US Direct Hire positions, associated support costs, and other necessary expenses to implement the reorganization. Most changes are within the Diplomatic Programs account, with selected bureau-specific changes for other appropriations and funding sources. No funds would be transferred between appropriations at this time. As Department implements this reorganization, it will continue to monitor any potential adjustments in bureau allocations, and notify as Congress as appropriate.

Report to Congress on the Reporting Structure of the Bureau of Cyberspace and Digital Policy

Consistent with section 1(i)(4)(B) of the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956, the Department of State is submitting this report regarding its intent to realign the Bureau of Cyberspace and Digital Policy (CDP) to report to the Under Secretary for Economic Growth, Energy, and Environment (E).

Since its establishment, CDP has played a central role in advancing U.S. diplomatic initiatives in cyberspace and digital policy, including international engagement on cybersecurity, countering foreign cyber threats, and negotiating multilateral agreements on digital standards. It will continue to do so. Realigning the CDP Bureau to report to E is part of the broader restructuring of the Department of State, as outlined in a separate congressional notification, and one that will better align – and indeed, elevate – CDP’s central functions with functions across the rest of the Department.

The E family is broadly focused on promoting U.S. commercial, trade, and business interests across the world. CDP has a crucial role promoting America’s leading technology industry and standards across globe. Realigning CDP to report to E will ensure that these interests are intertwined with the Department’s trade and commercial diplomacy activities. CDP’s capacity to advance the interests of American technology abroad will be supplemented with the functions, and certain personnel, of the offices of the Special Envoy for Critical and Emerging Technology (S/TECH) and the Science and Technology Adviser (STAS). Functions of OES’ Office of Science and Technology Cooperation will also be realigned to CDP. Following the planned reorganization, CDP will be even more effective in leading the

Department's efforts in commercial cyber activity. As CDP focuses on its statutory role and commercial priorities, certain functions of the bureau will be realigned to other Department components. Under the direction of E, CDP will better coordinate with these and other Department components to advance U.S. foreign policy. Taking these considerations into account, the Department assesses that realigning CDP to report to E will help the head of the bureau to carry out CDP's statutory functions more effectively.

The Department has undertaken a consultation process regarding the change in reporting lines both within and outside the Department, and will continue to listen to feedback from these and other stakeholders through engagement on the broader reorganization. For example, congressional briefings on the broader Department reorganization included plans for the reporting line for CDP. Department leadership also held several extensive internal consultations, including consulting with affected bureaus, Under Secretaries / Senior Officials, and with the broader Department workforce, who submitted various comments about CDP as part of the broader reorganization deliberations. The Secretary, who is serving as the National Security Advisor, has also considered interagency equities and concluded that the proposed moves further the broader interests of the United States and federal government.
